FY2012 Water Smart Rebate Program

Citrus County Utilities is offering its customers a series of rebate incentives to promote water conservation.

AVAILABLE REPLACEMENT REBATES

- High Efficiency and Ultra Low Flow Toilets [Complete Units*] - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of toilet)
- High Efficiency Clothes Washers** - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of washer)
- Weather Based Irrigation Controller or Soil Moisture Sensor - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of controller)
- Rain Sensor - up to \$ 50 (not to exceed cost of sensor)

TO QUALIFY

- Water efficient equipment must be installed on a property that receives water and/or sewer service from the Citrus County Utilities.
- Equipment must be purchased between 01/01/12 and 06/01/12. Rebate application must be received by 06/15/2012.
- Participants agree to an installation verification visit.
- Participants agree to complete a post-installation survey.

RESTRICTIONS APPLY

- Limit per Household: (2) toilets, (1) high-efficiency washer, (1) weather-based irrigation controller and/or (1) rain or moisture sensor.
- Amount of the rebate not to exceed purchase price of device.
- Rebates do not include sales tax, installation costs, delivery charges and other material costs.
- Homes constructed after 12/31/1995 are not eligible for a toilet rebate.
- Toilets must be a complete unit, i.e. they can be one piece (tank and bowl as one unit) or two pieces (tank and bowl) to be fitted together for a complete unit. Rebate also applies to dual flush toilets, ultra low flow urinals and waterless urinals.
